Move to new Pioneer course

- New design is complete and has been tested.
- New course will enable Bogus to use for Youth Summer Program. GSDG can provide instructor.
- Baskets, tee signs, and kiosk will be moved in June timeframe.
 - Paint orange rocks to place around tee and basket sleeves. This will enable us to find each June.
- Baskets and tee signs will be removed and stored each winter (Oct – Jun).
- Q: Where should we put kiosk? Near ski check-in building across from lodge would be ideal. JJ to ask Steve.
 - Include mailbox with map+scorecard
 - Include registration book (in weatherproof box) to collect the numbers
- JJ would recommend a course at the bottom near main lodge. Would be ideal for summer BBQ every Saturday and Sunday.
- JJ to check on new map for kiosk. Spatial Dynamics made previous one and is vendor for ski maps.
- JJ to purchase 6 trash cans to place around the course. Will use liners, and GSDG will empty cans when full.
- Restrooms are open all summer at Pioneer Lodge.

Events

- Re-negotiate event charges by Bogus.
 - Q: Can Bogus sponsor two free event days in exchange for title sponsorship? No
 - Current rate is half off (\$150/day).
 - Bogus has increased the daily fee to \$360, but will keep existing \$150 per event fee for disc golf (over half off now).
 - Other events (Wild Rockies mtn. bike race) have to pay \$1000 bond in case Bogus requires cleaning up the mountain afterwards.
 - GSDG has annual insurance policy for events at Bogus, and Bogus is listed on the policy.
- Bogus Basin Bash – Oct 17 is OK, and Bogus will combine with their party. Camping is allowed at Pioneer parking lot.
